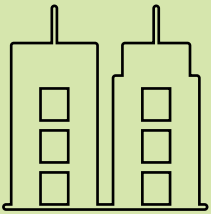


STUDENT MIX OF **MORE

You will have access to the Student Experience team to assist you with your desired subjects at the right level and credit value to match your requirements.

WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW ABOUT STUDY ABROAD AT **KBS**

The KBS Study Abroad Program offers students an opportunity to study at KBS Australia for one or two trimesters, and then transfer back to their home institution. This is available for students from any university or higher education provider. Tuition fees are paid to KBS Australia based on the number of subjects undertaken. Approval for credit recognition is still required if students wish to limit disruption to their program at their home institution.

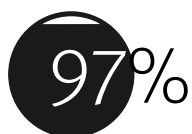

ACCOMMODATION AND COST OF LIVING

There are a variety of accommodation options available across all major Australian cities, depending on your needs:

MANAGED STUDENT ACCOMMODATION

Want to live in accommodation where you'll be able to socialise with other students? There are purpose-built student residences where the entire block is dedicated to the housing of 100-400 students. There are a wide range of room options, with shared kitchens and lounges, and either private or shared bathrooms.

The price typically includes all utilities, a furnished bedroom, 24-hour security and on-site staff support, social events and activities, communal laundry facilities as well as recreation areas. For example, cinema rooms, gyms, table tennis, gaming, television, BBQs, etc.

UniLodge and Scape are two large providers of managed student accommodation in Australia.

STUDENT HOSTELS

Student hostels offer you an affordable housing option where you'll be responsible for preparing your meals and sharing the cost of utilities such as gas, water and electricity.

Most hostels include a furnished bedroom (either private or shared) with access to communal facilities such as bathroom, laundry, kitchen and lounges.

PRIVATE RENTALS

If you'd like to be more independent, you can rent a property either on your own or rent a room in a private property. Living here, you'll be responsible for all utility costs (or sharing them) and preparing all your meals.

Though you can find fully or partially furnished private rentals, usually you are responsible for providing your furniture.
