

ATHLETE SUPPORT SCHOLARSHIP

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

These terms and conditions are applicable to individuals who have submitted an application to Kaplan Business School for a Kaplan Business School Athlete Support Scholarship ('Student'). By submitting a scholarship application, Students are deemed to have accepted these Terms and Conditions.

1. Kaplan Business School Athlete Support Scholarships are intended to support professional athletes during the COVID-19 outbreak. For Students who Kaplan Business School awards a Kaplan Business School Athlete Support Scholarship, Kaplan Business School will waive the enrolment fee (normally \$285) and offer a 50% discount of the tuition fees for (as applicable):
 - the eligible non-award single subject(s) that the Student nominated in the Student's scholarship application ('Subject(s)'); or
 - the eligible qualification/course that the Student nominated in the Student's scholarship application ('Course').

Students will be responsible for 100% of any other Subject/Course costs including administration, deferral and assessment resubmission fees, study materials, textbooks and stationery. See clauses 2 and 3 below for a list of eligible Subjects and Courses.

Students awarded this scholarship must commence their studies in 2020.

The course fees listed are 2020 tuition fees only and may be subject to change. Additional administrative fees and charges may be payable, for more information, visit www.kbs.edu.au/fees.

2. For Subjects, there are limits on the number of non-award single subjects that Students can nominate in their scholarship application. A Student can select up to:
 - four (4) subjects offered in the Diploma of Business or Bachelor of Business;
 - three (3) subjects offered in the Graduate Certificate in Accounting, Master of Professional Accounting or Master of Accounting;
 - three (3) subjects offered in the Graduate Certificate in Business Analytics, Graduate Diploma of Business Analytics, Master of Business Analytics or Master of Business Analytics (Extension); or
 - two (2) subjects offered in the Graduate Certificate in Business Administration, Graduate Diploma of Business Administration or Master of Business Administration.
3. For Courses, a Student can select the Diploma of Business, Graduate Certificate in Business Administration, Graduate Certificate in Business Analytics or Graduate Certificate in Accounting.

4. Students must abide by all applicable Kaplan Business School student policies including those relating to admission, enrolment, assessment, progression, and academic integrity and misconduct. Copies of these policies are available on the Kaplan Business School website.
5. Kaplan Business School will select successful scholarship applicants at its sole discretion and is not obliged to award any minimum number of scholarships.
6. Scholarship applications must be submitted to Kaplan Business School by email at scholarships@kbs.edu.au by 5:00pm (AEST) on 20 November 2020. Late applications will not be considered.
7. Students eligible to be considered for a Kaplan Business School Athlete Support Scholarship are those who satisfy all the following criteria:
 - Are at least 18 years of age at the time of course commencement;
 - Are a professional athlete, registered with one or more of the following groups or associations:
 - Australian Institute of Sport
 - State institutes or academies of sport
 - AFL Players Association
 - Australian Cricketers Association
 - Rugby League Professionals Association
 - Rugby Union Players Association
 - Australian Professional Footballers Association
 - National senior squad members from Australian Sports Commission-recognised sports
 - Another group or association that Kaplan Business School considers (in its sole discretion) is equivalent or similar to the groups/associations listed above
 - Have not previously studied, commenced studies or applied to study with Kaplan Business School
 - Meet the entry requirements for the Subject(s)/Course, including English and academic requirements. Admission Requirements Policy is available on the Kaplan Business School website.
8. Successful applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application by receiving an Offer of Admission which includes the scholarship acknowledgement. Kaplan Business School will use reasonable efforts to notify successful applicants no later than five (5) working days from the date their application was submitted. If a Student's application is successful, the Student will be required to accept or reject (via email) the Kaplan Business School's Offer of Admission. If Kaplan Business School has not received the Student's acceptance of the offer by the course commencement date, the offer will lapse, and the Student will be deemed to have rejected Kaplan Business School's offer.
9. Kaplan Business School's decision on the awarding of scholarships is final and no further correspondence will be entered into in relation to the outcome.

10. For Students who are awarded the scholarship, they must commence studies in the Subject(s) or Course on the dates outlined in the Offer of Admission.
11. Students who are awarded the scholarship in a Course must maintain continuous study in the Course for the duration of the scholarship (i.e. commence the next subject in the Course on completion of the previous), unless Kaplan Business School agrees otherwise in writing (noting that Kaplan Business School will likely accommodate Students who may have periods of intense training and playing schedules that necessitate reasonable breaks in their period of study. Students who do not meet these conditions may have their scholarship terminated by Kaplan Business School. Note this clause 11 does not apply to non-award single subjects.
12. Without limiting the above, Students who are awarded the scholarship may also have their scholarship terminated if they:
 - Withdraw from a Subject or Course or fail to enrol;
 - Do not maintain satisfactory academic performance;
 - Are determined by Kaplan Business School to be guilty of serious misconduct, including, but not limited to, having provided false or misleading information as part of their scholarship application;
 - Do not resume study of their Course at the end of any breaks in their period of study agreed by Kaplan Business School (see clause 11 above); or
 - Breach these Terms and Conditions.

If a Student is found guilty of serious misconduct or withdraws from a Subject or Course (other than due to exceptional circumstances beyond the Student's control, as determined by Kaplan Business School), Kaplan Business School reserves the right to request that any fees or other amounts waived by Kaplan Business School in connection with the Subject(s) or Course be paid to Kaplan Business School. If such a request is made, the Student must pay the fees and other amounts to Kaplan Business School's nominated account within 21 days after that request.

13. Scholarships awarded cannot be transferred, deferred, redeemed for cash or used in conjunction with any other scholarship, offer or promotion offered by Kaplan Business School.
14. Kaplan Business School handles personal information in accordance with its Privacy Policy (available at www.kbs.edu.au). Kaplan Business School may use the personal information a Student has included in connection with the Student's application for the purposes of considering their application, communicating with them about their application and otherwise administering the scholarship. Students who do not wish to have their personal information handled in this way should contact the Kaplan Privacy Officer at privacy@kaplan.edu.au.
15. Students who are awarded the scholarship may (at Kaplan Business School's discretion) be required to participate in promotional activities, including but not limited to photo shoots and completing a testimonial for Kaplan Business School for Kaplan Business School's website or other promotional purposes.

16. By submitting an application for the scholarship, each Student agrees to waive, release, and discharge Kaplan Business School, its officers, employees and related entities from any and all liability (including but not limited to consequential loss, loss of opportunity or loss of income) that could arise in connection with the scholarship, including any loss incurred if the Student is awarded a scholarship and that scholarship is later terminated in accordance with these Terms and Conditions.
17. Kaplan Business School may update or vary these Terms and Conditions at any time without prior notice.
