PAID WORK WHILE STUDYING

Generally, students that have commenced their studies are able to work up to 48 hours per fortnight while their course is in session. During holidays (when their course is not in session), they may be able to work additional hours.

WORK INTEGRATED LEARNING (WIL)

Students can complete unpaid internships part time for 12 weeks during the trimester periods which is credited towards their study.

GRADUATE ROLES

Our graduates and alumni are prepared for the workplace through the comprehensive and professional nature of our education, plus the services and guidance they receive from Careers Central. We can help you to recruit graduates directly into paid roles.

VOLUNTEERING

Students can volunteer their time to support local not-for-profits and charities in their local communities. They can also volunteer for events, conferences, or workshops.

AFTER SUCCESSFULLY COMPLETING A BACHELOR'S OR MASTER'S DEGREE, YOUR INTERN MAY BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR A POST-STUDY WORK ARRANGEMENT IN AUSTRALIA. FOR EMPLOYERS IN AUSTRALIA, THERE ARE NO ADDITIONAL COSTS TO PAY WHEN RECRUITING APPLICANTS WHO HOLD THESE VISAS. HOW CAN YOU BENEFIT FROM HOSTING INTERNS?

Internships provide KBS students with an opportunity to build local work experience as well as see the inner workings of Australian businesses. For employers, hosting an intern has numerous benefits including:

- Training possible recruits and pipelining talent
- Filling resource gaps with an extra pair of hands
- Leveraging off fresh perspectives
- Working with multilingual and multicultural students to gain insights into international markets
- Strengthening diversity within your business
- A cost-effective solution to your recruitment needs.

WORK INTEGRATED LEARNING (WIL) Students can elect to complete a WIL internship with a business in Australia and receive academic credit upon successful completion of the internship. Businesses can recruit WIL students to take on various business administration duties for a 12-week term. You are required to host WIL students 2 days per week. You will also be required to provide constructive feedback to the student at the end of the placement. WIL students can be selected from both our undergraduate and postgraduate cohorts, depending on the level of complexity in the role you are recruiting for. The WIL program has three intakes per year commencing in March, July, and November.

WORK-INTEGRATED LEARNING PARTNERSHIP APPROACH

Our Careers Central team will work with you to ensure the terms of each WIL Internship are clearly documented and agreed. We will provide you with an agreement and related documentation. This three-way partnership between you as the host, the KBS Careers Central team as the facilitator and the student as the intern will result in a successful experience for all. Our KBS Careers Central team will work with you to monitor the student's learning and workplace performance, as well as provide ongoing support to all parties. We can also host your brand logo on key marketing collateral including our website.



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to pay the intern?	No, interns are unpaid as each internship is a registered vocational placement through Kaplan Business School.
What is required of me as an employer?	To provide a learning experience for our interns. Vocational placements can give students important skills to help them transition successfully from study to work, while giving you the opportunity to enrich student learning experiences and increase the number of work-ready graduates.
What can interns do?	They can support you with completing a wide array of entry-level tasks and projects. This can include a combination of observational and practical tasks that aid the intern's skill development and learning.
How many hours per week can interns work?	17 hours per week.
Are there any fees to your services?	No, our services are complimentary.
Can I employ the student after the placement contract finishes?	Yes, our Careers Central team can assist you with this if required.
Can we host more than one intern at a time?	Yes, however your requirements will be assessed by our Careers Central team and advice given accordingly. This assessment will look at various factors including WHS, physical capacity and desk space within your business, mentor support, and the intern roles and responsibilities.
Is there an obligation to employ someone after the placement?	No, there are no obligations to employ an intern.
