T3 2016

From T1:

Subjects will have either a Test or Assignment between Week 3 & 6.

We will restock & supply our kitchens in the Student Breakout areas.

Revision slides will be available during study week.

Annual subject offerings will be released across each Campus.

T1 2017

From T2:

Exam timetables will be released by Week 6 each trimester.

No more 2 or 3 hour exams will be scheduled at the same time.

Library books that were previously on a 3 day loan will now be available on a 7 day loan.

Every campus to get at least one phone charging station.

T2 2017

From T3:

Students will be able to complete an Academic Internship.

There will be just one SELTS survey to complete per trimester.

Timetables will be made available from Week 12.

Results of any final assessments will be made available on release date.

T3 2017

From T1:

We will trial evening classes from 5.15pm - 8.15pm.

All in-trimester class tests will be returned to students temporarily in class for review.

Each campus will subscribe to a range of business magazines.

T1 2018

From T2:

We will trial offering all core MBA subjects every trimester.

Coloured recycling bins will be introduced in each of our campuses.

New games will be provided for the breakout area.

Power board towers will be installed in key areas.

We will commit to ordering over 500 additional, prescribed textbooks for our libraries.

Students will be emailed when in-trimester grades are released.

T2 2018

From T3:

At least one power board tower will be installed in each classroom.

We will trial video conferencing equipment in one MBA class on each campus.

Exam papers will include sections for more extensive feedback.

We will Introduce non-dairy milk, a greater selection of tea bags & kitchen condiments in our breakout areas.

Another 500 textbooks will be purchased for our libraries.

T3 2018

From T1:

School email addresses will be provided so you can access Microsoft Office for free

Results & Progress feature on KHUB introduced.

No more out-of-class group assignments.

No more assessments worth more than 40%.

No more classes that run longer than 3 hours.

We will no longer use Perdisco as part of our courses.

Introduction of accounting software Xero, free of charge for KBS students.

T1 2019

From T2:

Graduation ceremonies will now be held every eight months.

Introduction of a Deans' Award for our highest performers.

The same login will work for both systems (MyKBS & KHUB).

We will double the amount of time each counsellor is available.

We'll be purchasing more lockers for each campus.

T2 2019

From T3:

MBA students can choose 2 specialisations.

The Student Ambassadors Program will be provided a budget for student events.

We will run migration seminars and Xero workshops every trimester.

We will organise exclusive KBS student discounts at local gyms.

T3 2019

From T1:

New subjects and elective spaces introduced in our Master of Accounting.

Free 24/7 off-campus support both online and in person provided via our partner app Sonder.

We will facilitate at least one industry tour per campus.

New Internship credit subject in the Master of Accounting.

Dedicated space and computer for students to book for video presentation.

Hand hygiene pumps installed around campus.

T1 2020

From T2:

We will include the times of all Online classes on KHUB.

There will be no more assessments in Weeks 1 and 2.

We will archive the recordings of MBA industry guest presentations delivered online.

All future Xero workshops will be available to all KBS students irrespective of their course.

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T2 2020

From T3:
We will be implementing a further financial support package

Significantly increase the number of available counselling appointments.

Relaunch casual job postings through the job board on MyKBS.

Implement single sign on functionality for OpenAthens.

Run a series of online workshops on h presentation skills

T3 2020

From T1:
No annual increase in fees for the duration of 2021. The average sector-wide annual increase is 5%.

We will schedule 35% more classes face-to-face and will begin holding workshops on campus.

We'll abolish all final exams beginning with Level 100 subjects in T2, Level 200 in T3, and Level 300 and postgrad courses in 2022.

We will revamp the MyKBS page and a more regularly updated homepage.

T1 2021

From T2:
We will launch a new password reset tool that is easier to use.

Each trimester, awards for academic endeavour, campus engagement and careers excellence will be open to all students .

MBA509, Artificial Intelligence Programming for Business Analytics, will be launched in Trimester 2, 2021.

MBA508, Internship 2, will be launched in Trimester 2, 2021 allowing students to complete two academic internships as part of their course.

T2 2021

From T3:
We will trial issuing Uber (and Uber Eats) gift vouchers for achieving a High Distinction.

We will create an extra tab where all your Zoom recordings will be stored from T3 onwards.

We will provide a PDF outlining when the assessment due dates are for each subject.

In MyKBS, we have created a space where lecturer support hours are now readily available.

T3 2021

From T1:
We will be launching a brand new Student Portal that will allow you to subject enrol, manage your finances, lodge requests and much more.

We will be launching a new library website with a range of significant improvements.

All students who complete an Academic Internship will receive a certificate of completion.

We're establishing a workgroup to focus on promoting face-to-face engagement for when we return to campus .

T1 2022

From T2:
You will see the lecturers' name in the summary page when you've chosen your subject.

We'll run a national workshop on the topic of tax to help.

We will launch an academic integrity online module in MyKBS.

We will provide official certification for class attendance as part of the Lifetime of Learning Guarantee.

We'll be revamping some of our Bachelor courses and subjects.*

T2 2022

From T3:
We will trial lowering the maximum capacity of online classes from 45 to 40 (noting this is a maximum capacity and the online class average is 27). Results & Progress feature on KHUB introduced.

We will trial delivering some online classes on a Saturday.

Various works are happening across all campuses from now until the end of the year, including painting, renovations, new furniture and more BYOD (bring-your-own-device) friendly environments.

T3 2022

From T1:
We will incorporate nominations from students in the Academic Awards program every trimester.

We will deliver a MYOB software workshop.

We will host trimester based alumni welcome and reunion events around the time you finish your last assessment.

We will make sure recommended texts are all either available online or removed from the list.

T1 2023

From T2:
We will Create a comprehensive FAQ on the 'Return to campus'

We will run a Power BI workshop for all students.

We will subscribe to another 384 journal publications which means over 30,000 additional articles

We will continue to invest in our campuses. We've undertaken renovations, acquired additional furniture, enhanced our study spaces, recruited further IT support and timetabled a significant increase in classes.

Introduced small group consultations and open consultation hours on each campus, where you don't have to book an appointment.

From T1:
