

## **FAQs for prospective students on Trimester 2 Accelerated (T2X)**

Q: When does T2X commence?

Q: How many weeks does T2X run for?

T2X runs for 6 weeks, plus 1 exam week for those subjects that have exams: ACCM4000 Financial Accounting and ACCM4100 Management Accounting.

Q: What is the minimum subject load I need to undertake?

Students can undertake a minimum of 1 subject to meet the full-time study requirement for this 6-week trimester. However, students are allowed to undertake a maximum of 2 subjects.

Q: Will I have access to all courses in T2X

KBS will be offering only Post Graduate (PG) courses in T2X. Please see a list of PG courses in this [list](#).

Yes. T2X ends on 6<sup>th</sup> November 2020. Students will then join the standard T3 intake commencing on Monday 16th November.

Q: Can I study a single subject either as a cross institutional student or as non-award study?

Yes, eligible students can apply for cross institutional or non-award study in T2X.

Q: Will the subjects be offered Face-to-face on campus or online?

T2X subject offerings will only be available online.

Q: Will T2X be offered in all 5 campuses in Australia?

Yes. T2X is offered in all our campuses – Sydney, Melbourne, Brisbane, Adelaide and Perth However the Masters of Accounting and Masters of Professional Accounting are not offered in Perth in 2020).

Q: How many days will I be attending classes?

One subject load requires students to attend a 3-hour online class per week. This does not include preparation and other study requirements related to the selected subject.

Q: Will I get the same student support as other Trimesters offered at KBS?

Q: Can I enrol into T2X from overseas and study online?

Yes. As always, students need to seek independent advice on visas.

Q: What is the course and subject fee of the courses offered in T2X

Q: Can I apply for the standard Trimester 3 now instead of T2X?

Yes. T2X offers a fantastic option of studying a 1 subject load. However, this will not be available in Trimester 3. Trimester 3 requires a minimum of a 2subject study load.

Q: Can I, as a current student of KBS, undertake T2X?

T2X is only available to new students. Current students will follow the standard Trimesters.
